

Pre-lesson Vocabulary Review

If your resource is **CURRENT**, it means that its information is recent or new enough that it is useful to answer your questions about your invention.

If your resource is **ACCURATE**, it means that its information is exactly right, without any mistakes, so you can use it for your invention.

If your resource is **FOCUSED**, it means that its information is mostly or completely about your topic so that you can find what you need for your invention.

If your resource is **TRUSTWORTHY**, it means that its information is honest and truthful.

EXPERTISE means that the author or creator of the information is someone who has a lot of knowledge on that topic.

If your resource is **OBJECTIVE**, it means that its information is factual and isn't changed based on the author's or creator's personal feelings or opinions.

If your resource contains **REFERENCES**, it means that there are other sources provided within it that support the accuracy and truthfulness of the information you are using.

NAVIGATE means that you can easily find your way around your resource to find the information you need.

If your resource has **ENOUGH** information, it means it has everything you need to answer your questions.

If your resource has the **KIND** of information you need for creating your invention, it means it has the type of information required.

If you **UNDERSTAND** the information in your resource, it means that you know what that information means.

If your resource is **AVAILABLE**, it means that you are able to find it and use it.

If your resource is **WELL-ORGANIZED**, it means that it is easy for you to find the information that you are looking for.
